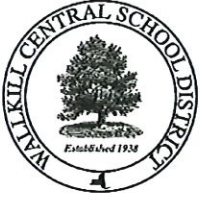

Dear Parents and Guardians,

***This letter shall serve as an update to my August 27, 2020 letter regarding meals for students. Recent federal and state decisions NOW allow the District to temporarily serve free meals to all students until December 31, 2020. This decision is subject to change at the federal government's discretion. The District still requires that households' complete applications for free and reduced meals as usual and return them as soon as possible. Meals will be provided at no cost should you make such request by completing our online form or contacting the Food Service Director at 895-7192.***

*In order to make this process as seamless as possible, we ask that you complete the Food Order Form online or call 845-895-7192, the day prior to service beginning (Monday through Friday). Calls received between 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. will be processed for the next meal service. Any calls received after 1:00 p.m. may not receive a meal service the following day but will be contacted with a start date for receiving meal service.*

### ***Meal Delivery Days***

*Monday – Provide a breakfast and lunch meal for Monday and Tuesday*

*Wednesday – Provide a breakfast and lunch meal for Wednesday and Thursday*

*Friday – Provide a breakfast and lunch meal for Friday*

*Meals will be delivered between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. The delivery time for each meal will vary based on the number of delivery requests we receive. The District and the bus contractor will be working collaboratively to build routes. A member of your household will need to be available to pick up the meal from the bus at the end of the driveway.*

*This meal service option will continue for the duration of remote learning or if you notify us to discontinue the service. When the hybrid model is utilized meals will continue to be delivered with additional information provided to families. Should you no longer need the meal service, please contact us at 845-895-7192 or 845-895-7102.*
