



Proposed Programs in the 2022-2023 Budget

Current -

- Maintain programs, extra-curricular activities and equipment money for technology
- Maintain low class sizes K-12 to allow for enhanced learning opportunities (K-6 average class size of 20)
- Professional Development opportunities to support classroom instruction and student learning
- > Maintain support services to address the mental well-being of our students
- > Police officers in all five (5) school buildings

New -

- > Create one (1.0) FTE High School American Sign Language position
- > Create one (1.0) FTE Groundskeeper position
- Eliminate one (1.0) FTE High School Math position through attrition due to declining enrollment and create one (1.0) FTE Elementary Education position (Math AIS)
 - > This will give the District three (3.0) FTE Elementary Math AIS positions with one assigned to each elementary building
