## **Wallkill Boys Lacrosse Spring Break Baltimore Trip 2022**

### **Safety Plan**

***Purpose:*** To establish group and individual safety guidelines for students that plan to travel to Baltimore, Maryland with the Wallkill Varsity Lacrosse Team during spring break from 4/9/22-4/13/22.

#### ***Travel Preparations:***

1. A parent meeting will be held at the high school to discuss the details of the Baltimore trip and to review COVID safety procedures students will adhere to following Board of Education approval.

#### ***Transportation, Hotel and Parks:***

1. All athletes and coaches will wear masks when riding in any vehicle as a team such as a bus or van.

2. All athletes and coaches will follow any masking rules set forth by the facilities and hotels.

3. The Wallkill High School Varsity Lacrosse players will function as one pod together but will contain smaller pods according to athlete's hotel accommodations.

4. Only the athletes that are sharing a hotel room may remove their masks in their assigned rooms. Every athlete must wear a mask when other Wallkill athletes enter a room that they were not assigned.

5. Coaches will always carry extra masks in case an athlete loses their facemask, or it becomes unserviceable.

6. Coaches will monitor face masks and adherence to guidelines ensuring that all safety procedures are followed.
