COMPUTER BASED TESTING (CBT)

- New York State Education Department (NYSED) announced that beginning in spring 2026 CBT will be required for the state assessments in grades 3-8.
- In preparation for the statewide implementation of CBT the following plan for CBT will be implemented in the district.






Triangulated data designed eligibility lists

- STAR (Spring and Fall) scaled scores
- Report Card average /Teacher Recommendations
- Student History of Services
- State tests results if/when available

STAR CBM screenings - incorporated to identify specific gaps

- Progress Monitoring (Fall Winter Spring)
- Also an additional data point for eligibility consideration



- Maximized student contact time in 6th grade in response to recent NY state exam results, screening results and identified gaps
- Provide resources to classroom teachers to enhance instruction and target identified classroom needs
- Maximized student contact time as much as schedules allow

REGENTS GRADE CALCULATION COMMITTEE



Prior to the 2021-2022 school year, Regents Exam Grades were counted as 20% of a student's overall average for courses that culminated in a Regents Exam.



The Board of Education approved a resolution (6/15/22) that authorizes the Superintendent, if necessary, to suspend compliance with policies 7301 and 7302 in the 2021-2022 school year.



As a result, a determination was made that at the secondary level we would not be including Regents Exams as 20% of a student's overall average, and final grades will be calculated using an average of the four (4) quarter grades for the 2021-2022 School Year

REGENTS GRADE CALCULATION COMMITTEE

- Committee met on:
 - 0 9/26/2022
 - 11/17/2022
- Gathered information from Ulster County Schools regarding how they calculate Regents Exam Scores in student GPA's.
- Committee members from ELA, Social Studies, Math, Science, Special Ed, and other departments polled their colleagues to receive feedback from teachers.
- Most teachers felt that the Regents needed to be calculated in the student's GPA, but that one-fifth (20%) of the student's grade was too heavily weighted.
- The committee created a matrix to identify how changing policy from 20% to 10% would impact student GPA's
- Taking all this information into consideration, the committee recommends that we change 7301 to read the following:

All final exams will be weighted as 1/10th (10 %) of final grade for half-year and full-year courses.
